Frequently Asked Questions – Results June 2021

This information is applicable to September start students who have repeat/deferral sessions in August only.

We have put together some frequently asked questions to help you as you get your exam results. We hope this addresses the questions you may have. If your query is not answered below, please do contact your programme co-ordinator who will be happy to assist.

1. I have failed a module – will the repeat be a written examination?

- All examinations have been replaced with repeat Terminal Assignment Based Assessment (TABA). Adhering to government guidelines these will all be done by our students remotely.

2. I have failed a module or have been granted a major assessment/examination deferral - what do I need to do?

- If you have failed or did not attempt a module(s) you must attempt the repeat TABA. This will be recorded as your first attempt.
- You must also register with Exams Office. Please go to the Exams page on the NCI website for further details.
- If you have been granted a major assessment/examination deferral you do not need to register with the Exams office for this. We advise that you refer to your Moodle page where your lecturer will update details on your submission.

3. I was granted a module deferral - what do I need to do?

- You will need to contact the college Admissions team in advance of the academic year 2021/2022 to arrange your registration – we recommend you do this two months in advance of the September start date.
