## How to Register Online - 2017/18

Students can register online by accessing the website <u>www.ncirl.ie/newstudents</u>. If you have forgotten your password or have not previously received one, please see the enclosed **Student NCI IT Services and Facilities – Getting Started sheet.** 

You will need access to a computer with internet connection and a credit<sup>1</sup>/debit card and your username and password in order to register online.

Please note you must complete Online Registration before the date of your first class. If you do not register before this date you must present yourself to the Fees Office to pay in person.

- 1. To register online go to <u>www.ncirl.ie/newstudents</u> and click on the link for returning students and follow the instructions on the page.
- 2. When prompted at any point for your username enter it in the following format; X and your student number e.g. x16100000
- 3. When you are logged in you will see your name in the upper right hand corner of the screen. Click on the "1 new icon" and then click confirm a Place.

- 5. If you are a part time student you will be able to choose to either;
  - Pay 50% of the course fee in order to be fully registered.

## OR
