
Returning Part Time Students – Fee Payment

The process for paying fees has changed so please ensure you the read below carefully.

You will need a credit/debit card to hand (please note that amex is not accepted).

Where do I go to Pay Fees?

- In order to pay your fees for the upcoming academic year you will need to login to MyDetails
- Remember your username is X + students number e.g. x12345678
- Remember your password is separate to Office 365. If you need to reset your MyDetails password go here https://mydetailsreset.ncirl.ie/showLogin.cc
- When you click the Courses tab



Click on the course that Starts in September 2022



• You will see a Pay Fees button associated with the upcoming year. Click on it.

Pay Fees – Additional Steps

- Before you can make a payment, you must ensure address details are correct and fill out any mandatory fields.
- You will also be asked to fill out the Equal Access Survey (EAS). This is a survey conducted by
 institutions on behalf of the HEA. The survey is not mandatory, however answering the
 questions helps the HEA develop a better understanding of the student population and their

Fee Payment

- You will see the total outstanding balance listed.
- There are a number of options for payment;

1. 20% Payment & Direct Debit

Pay 20% of the outstanding payment and fill out, sign, scan and return the <u>direct debit form</u> to fees@ncirl.ie. Information on the direct debit schedule can be found here.

2. 50% Payment

Pay 50% of the outstanding balance before your course recommences and the remainder before Semester 2. (The Pay Fees Service will remain open throughout the year for you to make additional payments).

3. 100% Payment

Pay the full outstanding amount as listed on screen.

4. Company Sponsorship

If you are being sponsored by your employer. Fill out, sign, scan and return the <u>sponsorship</u> form to <u>fees@ncirl.ie</u>. You

If you are being part sponsored by your work, you can still use the service to pay the amount you will be funding yourself.

Please note you will not be registered until the fees office have received the sponsorship form.
