

# Sparkhire- One Way interview

Congratulations on reaching the next step in the application process.

The Sparkhire interview is a great way for you to demonstrate your knowledge in the area that you are applying for.

The Course Director will review your Sparkhire Interview once completed and the Springboard Office will be in touch with the decision.

This training manual is a guide to prepare you for your one-way interview. You will have practice interview questions before the interview begins which will test your camera and your microphone. It is mandatory that you read this manual before you begin your interview.

Some important tips before you start!

- When doing the interview from a **desktop/laptop computer**, you'll need webcam and microphone capabilities along with the <u>Google Chrome Web Browser</u>. Please note that Google Chrome is the recommended web browser (even on a Mac).
- 1. If you are concerned about your wifi connection, we recommend that users download and use the **Sparkhire Mobile App** <u>https://www.sparkhire.com/mobile-app</u> (Open email on your mobile and click on the test link that we sent you and proceed to 'Go to your interview', this will then give you the option to download the Sparkhire app)

# Preparing for your interview

- 1. Understanding what a one-way interview is; A one-way interview is where interviewers request applicants to record video responses to a series of pre-drafted questions. You will be able to see how you look to us but there will be nobody on the other end.
- 2. Prepare your area for taking the interview;
  - Plain background
  - Good lighting
  - Speak clearly
  - Dress appropriately
  - Make sure the area where you will be taking the interview is free from noise & ensure you won't be interrupted during your interview.
  - Read the instructions provided







# The Interview itself

Step 1 - Applicants will receive details of the interview by email.

**Step 2** – Applicants click on the interview link from the email they receive and are brought to the below page. Applicants are advised to read the details below and click on the "Go to your interview" button when ready.
