Overview:

40 students graduated from BA (Hons) Accounting and Finance in November 2024. We surveyed these graduates in April 2025 and have graduate outcomes information for 26 graduates. 85% were in employment. 12% were engaged in further study or training.

Salary:

Of those in employment who disclosed salaries, 75% earned between €25,000 - €29,999, 12% earned between €30,000 - €34,999, and 12% reported earnings of €40,000 - €44,999.

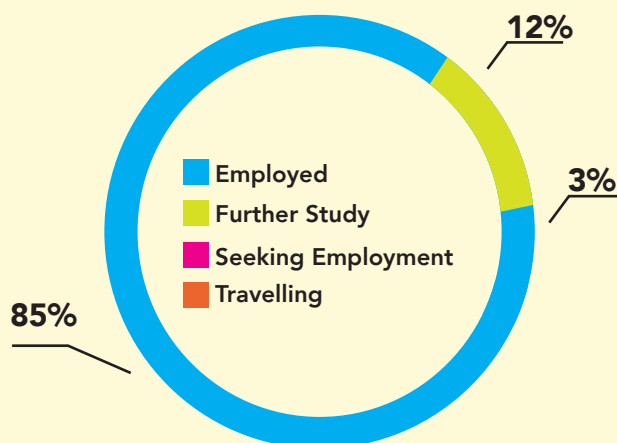
