### Overview:

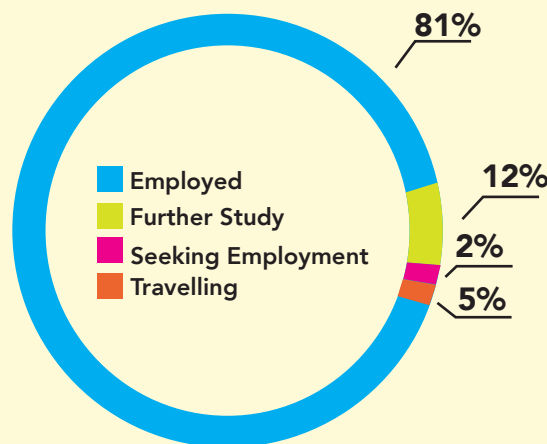
46 BA (Hons) Human Resource Management students graduated in November 2024. We have Graduate Outcomes Data for 42 graduates (91% response rate). 81% were in employment. 12% of the respondents were engaged in further study or training.

### Salary:

Of those in employment who disclosed salaries 47% earned between €30,000- €34,999 and 35% earned between €35,000 - €39,999, 12% reported earnings of €40,000 - €44,999 and 6% reported a salary of €45,000 - €49,999.
