### Overview:

48 students graduated from the BSc (Hons) Computing in November 2024. We surveyed these graduates in April 2025 and have graduate outcomes information for 60% of them. 69% were in employment and 10% were engaged in further study or training.

### Of those in employment:

Of those in employment who disclosed their salary, 11% reported earning between €30,000 and €34,999, 22% between €35,000 and €39,999, 22% between €40,000 and €44,999, 11% between €45,000 and €49,999, and 33% between €50,000 and €59,999.

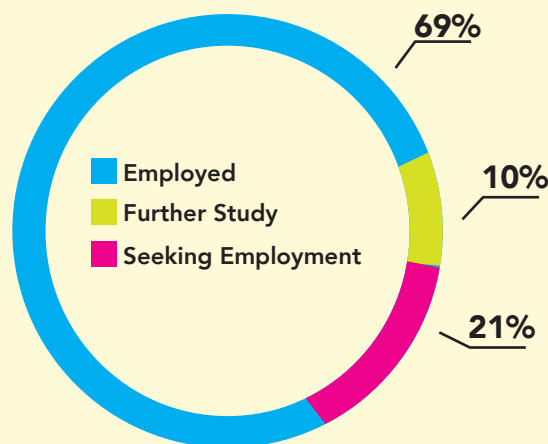
