Overview:

- 44 students graduated from the BA (Hons) Human Resource Management in November 2021.
- We have graduate outcome data for 95% of graduates. 75% were employed and all were employed in graduate level roles. 23% were undertaking further study. 0% were seeking employment 2% were unavailable for work
- In 2020 8 2nd year BA (Hons) Human Resource Management students undertook a placement as part of their degree programme. 25% remained with companies they completed their placement with.
- 66% of those in employment were working in HR roles.
- 50% of graduates were working in roles that were advertised on NCI 360.
- 20% of graduates secured roles with employers that came on campus.



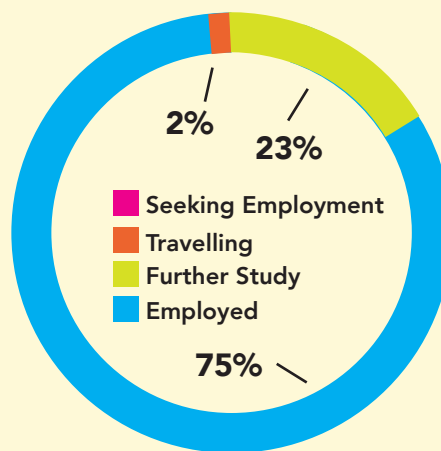
