Overview:

20 students graduated from the BA (Hons) Accounting & Finance November 2023. 80% of those that responded were in employment and 20% were undertaking further study.

63% of respondents first heard about their job through the careers service.

Salary:

Graduates reported starting salaries primarily between €25,000–€29,999 (45.5%) and €30,000–€34,999 (36.4%), with 9.1% earning between €60,000–€69,999.
