## Overview

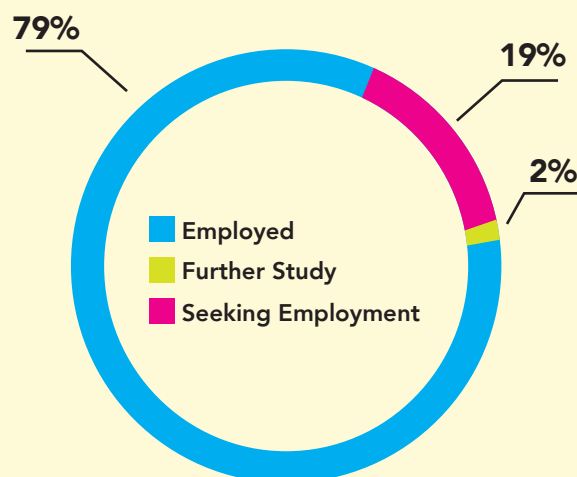
47 students graduated from the Master of Science in Finance course in 2023. 79% of those that responded were in employment and 2% were undertaking further study.
