### Key Points

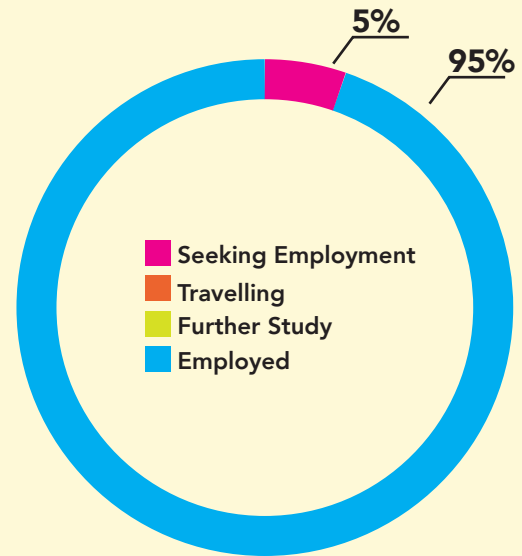
- Overall 95% of graduating students were employed and 95% of those employed were employed in graduate level roles.
- 33% of those employed were employed in roles advertised on NCI 360.
- 29% of those employed were employed with companies that came on campus
