

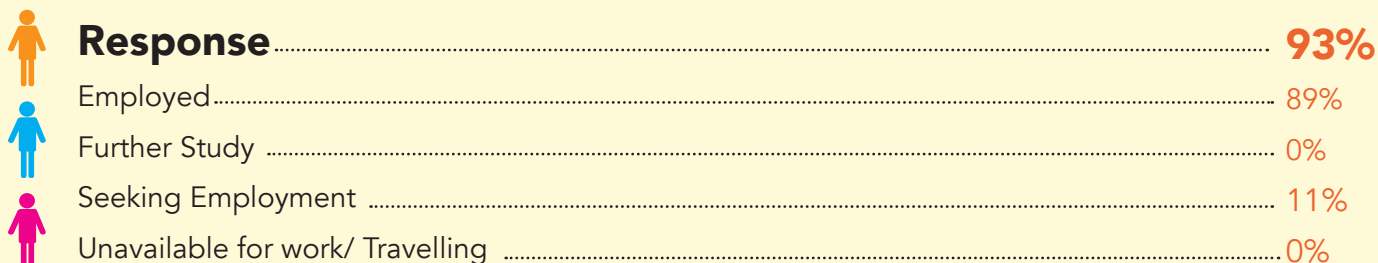

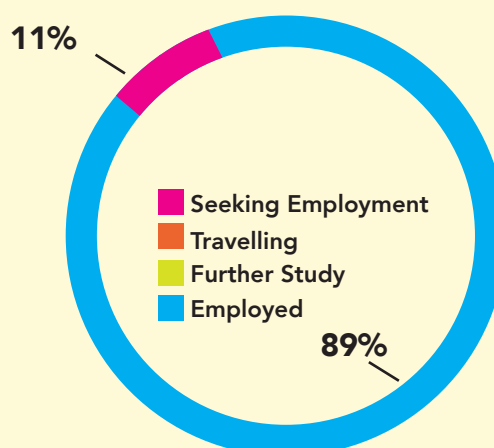
Overview:

- 30 students graduated from the Master of Science in Cloud Computing.
- The response rate was 93% and of those that responded 89% were employed. 11% were seeking employment. The students who were seeking employment at the survey cut off date have since found graduate level work. One with Focus Engineering as a Software Engineer another as a Server and Software Support Engineer at Terminalfour and the third graduate is now a Web Development and Cloud Engineer at Zarion.
- 80% of those that were employed were employed in graduate level work.
- 20% of graduates secured a role that was advertised through the Careers Service.
