- Describe any personal interests you have pursued. Which has given you the greatest sense of achievement?

#### **PwC**

- Briefly describe a situation where you set out to achieve something and reached your goal. (max 250 words)
- Briefly describe a situation in which you had to influence people and overcome objections to your viewpoint. (max 250 words)
- Why do you think you are suited to the career you have chosen? (max 250 words)
- How do you see your career developing over the next five years? (max 250 words)
- Please list your main extra-curricular interests and activities. Outline, where appropriate, your personal contribution to them and any relevant achievements obtained. (max 250 words)
- If there were any special circumstances during your secondary or third level education which resulted in you obtaining lower grades than expected, please indicate them here. (max 250 words)
- You will be required to list the subjects covered on your course including projects on the next page. All exams must be included
- School Results: Full results needed
- Please give full details of any work experience, starting with the most recent. Indicate whether it was full-time, part-time, vacation work or an industrial placement
