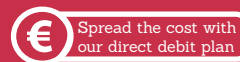

Course Description

This programme covers facilitation of learning and development plus digital and blended learning, for all those involved in the development of people. Alongside facilitation skills, we take the best-in-class theory and approaches and help you apply it to your organisation. Learning alongside other professionals, you will be taught by lecturers with years of practical experience. An innovative assessment structure is in place which promotes both the understanding of academic principles and the application of skill. Assessment is by means of skills assessments, projects, case assignments and exams.

Award
