**1**  
No Phones, Smart Watches  
or any other Smart /  
Wearable Technology.



**2**  
No Writing on your person,  
whether relating to the exam or not.



**3**  
No Food or Drink allowed.  
Water will be provided.



**4**  
No Hats, No Scarves.  
(with the exception  
of religious garments)



**5**  
No notes and no blank  
paper of your own.



**6**  
No pencil cases, Tipex  
or permanent markers.



**7**  
Basic Translation language  
dictionaries are allowed  
but must be submitted to  
the Exams Office minimum  
of two days in advanced of the Exam.



**8**  
Calculators are not allowed in some  
exams, check with your lecturer  
and confirm which type is permitted.  
Remember to bring your own!



**9**  
Students cannot leave within  
the first half hour and the last  
half hour of the exam.



**10**  
No speaking to other candidates.  
If you need assistance put up your  
hand for an invigilator.



**11**  
Students must place their  
student card on the desk  
for invigilators to view.



**12**  
Students are allowed to bring their  
student card, pens, pencils, highlighters,  
eraser, pencil sharpener, ruler and  
permitted calculators to the exam desk.  
There should be no notes on any item.
