



NCI Data Subject Rights Form

REQUEST TO EXERCISE DATA SUBJECT RIGHTS UNDER THE GENERAL DATA PROTECTION REGULATIONS (GDPR) AND DATA PROTECTION ACT 2018

Subject to circumstances, all data subjects, including students, staff, and users of services provided by the National College of Ireland (the College), have the ability to exercise the rights afforded to them under data protection legislation. Under GDPR and the Data Protection Act 2018, data subjects have the right, where appropriate, to

- Access
- Rectification
- Erasure or “the right to be forgotten”
- Restrict processing
- Data portability
- Object
- Rights in relation to automated decision making, including profiling

Timeline

A decision concerning your request will be made within 30 working days. In some circumstances, we will need to extend this response period by a further two months if we need extra time to consider your request. Your request will be proceeded with once your identity has been verified.

Complaints

If you are unhappy with a decision or response concerning your subject access request, you have the right to lodge a complaint with the Data Protection Commission. They will investigate your subject access request further for you.

- If further copies of information provided are requested, the National College of Ireland may charge a reasonable fee based on administrative costs
