
## Update My Details with your Irish Address





My Details reflects your details on the NCI Student Information System and you must update it with:

- your Irish Address
- your Irish Mobile Number
- your PPSN (when you get it)




My details is also where you will:

- access your exam results

## Update My Details with your Irish Address









(this is different to your student account password!)

Login with your Student ID e.g. x1234567



Update both the Home and Mailing address with your Irish Address

Allow 24 hours for your address to be updated on all systems.

## Self-generate your letters on Student Letter Hub



#### How do you access the Student Letter Hub

- Access with NCI360
- The link for it is on the NCI website / My apps and in support hub articles
- Or use your search engine and search for NCI360.ie



#### Who has access to the Student Letter Hub?

- The Letter Support Hub is only available to Registered Students.
- International Students are automatically registered by 17 January once they have:
  - Submitted their Registration Form
  - Hold a full offer
  - Paid fees in full or set up an approved payment plan

When can registered students access the Student Letter Hub? From 17 January




#### How do you self-generate letters?

- Select the letter you want and follow the instructions
- There is no limit on the number of letters you can request or how often

#### When do we get the letters?

Self-generated letters are emailed automatically
 & in real time to your student email

#### 1. Work in Ireland

- The rules for working are set by the Irish Government and not NCI
- Your student visa gives you a concession to work without a work permit.
- You can work 20 hours a week and full time (40 hours) at Christmas and Summer.

- Import Note: You also need a PPSN (Tax Number) to work and we cover this later



#### 2. Travel outside the Republic of Ireland

- Northern Ireland is part of the UK- so you <u>may</u> need a visa to travel there.

#### 3. Attendance Matters

We want you to succeed at your studies, and it is well documented that student success is linked to attendance.

#### **NCI Graduate advice:**

"My advice is to connect with your professors, be the part of the lecture, interact with everyone and give support to others, it will enhance you, not only in your career but in person."

- Immigration expect:- students to attend classes and they measure it with progression in their studies and/or completing\_within the original timeline.
- NCI expect: students to engage with and attend ALL learning activities and events associated with their course of study at the National College of Ireland.
  - NCI can measure student engagement with various activities such as students access to moodle, visiting library (in person or online), assessment submission and exam completion and random attendance checks.

#### **Attendance Frequently Asked Questions**

Q: What if I am sick and miss classes?

A: See the Attendance and Engagement FAQ and complete the Absence Form.

#### Q: What if I need to travel home (in emergency or planned)?

A: NCI cannot provide permission for students to miss classes or travel during their programme so if you must do so it is at your own risk.

If you decide to travel, please be advised that NCI cannot intervene with any decisions made by immigration regarding your visa status.

#### Q: Can I get a letter to show proof of attendance for immigration?

A: There is no letter that NCI provide for attendance. International Support provide letters to students to register with immigration for the first time and for immigration renewals.

#### Secure your Accommodation



Must secure accommodation first as:-







You can't use a Hostel, Hotel or AirBnB for a traditional bank account, to get your PPSN or for immigration





Accommodation Information for International Students





Temporary Accommodation

Information about temporary short stay lets such as hotels and hostels



Privately Rented Accommodation

Information and websites to help you find private accommodation options such as an apartment or house shares

#### 1. Secure your Accommodation

NCI do not own accommodation and don't have a placement service - you must find and secure your own accommodation

#### **Important!**

You need to secure your accommodation as you cannot use a Hostel or Airbnb address to:

- Open a traditional bank account
- Apply for your PPSN





2. Open a Bank Account

**Traditional High Street Bank Account** 







#### Online OR by visiting branch & get an appointment

- 1. **Proof of ID** = Passport
- 2. Evidence you are full time student = NCI student card and /or NCI Welcome Letter
- 3. **Proof of Address** = Utility Bill in your name at your address or NCI Bank Letter with your Irish Address that you request on NCI360 with the Student Letter Hub

#### **Digital Current Accounts**

**Money Jar** are an Irish Digital Current Account, so you get an Irish IBAN (International Bank Account Number).

**Proof of ID** = Passport **Verification** = Selfie

Set up **BEFORE you travel** to Ireland and use temporary address in Ireland

Money Jar have an offer for NCI students to get FREE Monthly Fee for 9 Months – you just pay the transaction fee – <u>linked to money jar guide with unique code for NCI students</u>





#### 3. Apply for a PPSN (Personal Public Services Number)

- A PPSN is required for your studies (you also need it if you plan to work)
- You must be in Ireland and have started at NCI
- You must have secured your accommodation & updated your address on MyDetails

#### **Required Documents:**

- 1. **Proof of ID** = Passport
- 2. **Proof of Address** = NCI PPSN Letter with your Irish Address you request this letter on NCI360 Student Letter Hub
- 3. Evidence of why you need a PPSN = NCI PPSN Letter confirms you need it for your studies

#### To get a PPSN you apply online, and you must:

- 1. Set up a basic account at MyGovID at mygovid.ie
- 2. Apply for the PPSN online and upload the required supporting documents at <a href="MyWelfare.ie">MyWelfare.ie</a>
- 3. When you make your application, you will make an appointment to visit a local INTREO office. You will need to print your letters for your appointment, and they will verify your details. Your PPSN card is posted to your address after your appointment.





#### 4. Register with Immigration

- You have 90 days after you land in Ireland to register with immigration
- You can only register after you started your studies this means you can only register after 22 January 2024.
- You must make an appointment with immigration and how you do that depends on where you live
- Living in Dublin phone 1800 800 630 to book appointment with immigration in Burgh Quay
- They will email you verification of your appointment
- Living outside Dublin make an <u>appointment with the local GNIB</u> Office at local Garda Station (Police)
- The Garda Station will record your appointment in a book

#### At your appointment you need the bring these documents:

- 1. Immigration Appointment Verification printed. (Only if living in Dublin)
- 2. NCI Immigration Letter printed. The letter is emailed to your student email, within 3 days of your scheduled welcome meeting.
- 3. NCI fees receipt printed
- 4. Medical Insurance
- 5. Passport
- 6. Credit/Debit Card to pay €300 fee (Forex accepted)
- 7. Proof of funds (if applicable)

**After your Appointment** - your Irish Residency Permit (IRP) card is posted your address within 10 to 15 working days.
