NCI POSTGRADUATE SCHOLARSHIP



Notes:

NCI is delighted to announce 30 postgraduate scholarships for full-time taught masters programmes for 2018/19.

30 postgraduate scholarships are available; 15 will be awarded to School of Business students and 15 will be awarded to School of Computing students.

WHAT IS THE VALUE OF THE SCHOLARSHIP?

The maximum amount covered by SUSI is $\in 6,270$; if the student is awarded this amount, the student scholarship will cover the remaining outstanding fee i.e. *the total course fee minus the maximum possible amount funded by SUSI*. Please see examples below;

In some cases the amount of the SUSI grant awarded is less than $\in 6,270$. If the student is awarded less than the maximum amount for the postgraduate grant or they are not awarded any funds they must undertake to pay the outstanding course fees themselves.

The value of the scholarship will always be "total course fees due - €6270 (maximum amount that can be awarded by SUSI)". Please see example below;

CRITERIA FOR APPLICATION

- The student must provide confirmation that they were in receipt of a SUSI Grant for their undergraduate degree within the past two academic years.
- Meet the academic entry requirements for their chosen postgraduate programme.
- If there is excess demand for the scholarship, applicants who have met the entry requirements will be ranked according to their final year results and will be notified in writing as to the success of their application and the amount of the scholarship after the 25th June 2018.

HOW TO APPLY

1. All applicants must fill out a Postgraduate Scholarship Form and submit before 4pm on the 31st May 2018.

WHAT COURSES ARE ELIGIBLE?

• If you have already applied for a full time taught masters programme you can fill in the Postgraduate Scholarship form attached which is to be submitted by 4pm Friday 25th May 2018.

¹ This form will be taken as an application therefore there is no need to fill out a separate application form for course choices

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- Students who have previously undertaken a postgraduate programme will not be eligible for this scholarship.
- No applications for the Postgraduate Scholarship will be accepted after the 31st May 2018.
- Students must be in financial and academic good standing with National College of Ireland by 25th June 2018 in order to be deemed eligible for the scholarship.
- External applicants must provide NCI with transcripts of their final year results before 25th June 2018 in order to confirm their eligibility.
- External applicants must also provide documentation to confirm they were in receipt of a SUSI Grant in their final year of their undergraduate degree.
- Only students who meet the entry requirements for the course will be eligible for the Postgraduate Scholarship.
- All courses are run subject to numbers. If a course is not eligible to run, NCI will make an offer for an alternative postgraduate taught master's programme in a cognate field where possible. If the student deems this alternative course unsuitable or no alternative can be offered, NCI will rescind the awarding of the scholarship.
- The Postgraduate Scholarship may not be deferred.
- Students who are granted the Postgraduate Scholarship and subsequently cease study will be ineligible to apply again.
- Students who are awarded the Postgraduate Scholarship will have the amount credited against their student fees.
- The onus is on the student to apply to SUSI (Student Universal Support Ireland the online student grant application system) for a postgraduate grant.
- · Students who don't pay outstanding balances of their fees will not be allowed to graduate.
- Payment plans for the outstanding fees are available and can be requested from the Fees Office located in Student Services.
- NCI students who are eligible for the Postgraduate Scholarship cannot avail of the €1,000 discount.
