TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- The closing date for this scholarship is 5pm, Friday 24th May 2024.
- Applicants must meet the International Protection criteria and be ineligible for state supports, such as the SUSI grant or Student Assistance Fund, for example. Successful applicants will be required to provide supporting documentation.
- · Applicants must live within commuting distance to NCI.
- The scholarship will cover full tuition fees, plus an allowance to cover transport, on-campus food, and the provision of a laptop device from NCI. The allowance will be assessed based on the circumstances of the individual student and will be solely at the discretion of NCI.
- Applicants must meet the minimum entry requirements for the programme they wish to undertake. NCI
 accepts applications from those who have work experience rather than academic qualifications through
 RPEL (Recognition of Prior Experiential Learning).
- · Applications are open to any full-time or part-time postgraduate programme, however only one scholarship will be awarded per programme. Should there be two or more equally qualified candidates for one programme, applications will be ranked based on date of application.
- · Applicants will be required to complete a programme application form in conjunction with the application for a scholarship.
- · Students applying for this scholarship should fill in this form and return to NCI by emailing admissions@ncirl.ie
- This scholarship cannot be used in conjunction with any other NCI scholarships and no cash or other alternatives can be given. Note that all NCI courses are run subject to student numbers and availability can change.
- The scholarship cannot be deferred and the recipient must commence their programme in the year the scholarship is awarded.
