Submissions should be no less than 300 and no more than 600 words in length and must be typed and e-mailed in 'soft copy' (preferable MS Word or PDF format) to <u>admissions@</u> <u>ncirl.ie</u> no later than **5pm** on **Friday 15th August 2025**.

Your submission should cover the following:

- An outline of your career to date and how an MBA would serve you at this juncture.
- Why you should be awarded this scholarship.
- You should also include a copy of your CV.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. APPLICATION PROCESS OVERVIEW:

Entrants must complete the above application form and make a submission, making their case for theaward of the scholarship. Applications and supporting documentation should be emailed to <u>admissions@ncirl.ie</u>. For more details see section 3: How to apply (below).

Applications will be accepted up to 5pm on the 15th August 2025. The recipients and unsuccessful applicants of the scholarships will be notified by e-mail. Please read all of the scholarship rules and additional information provided below prior to entering. By submitting an application, you are accepting the terms and conditions of the scholarship.

2. ELIGIBILITY:

This scholarship is only open to graduates of either the BA (Hons) HRM Practice and Strategy or the BA (Hons) Business Management, delivered in the evenings over 2 years.

Employees of National College of Ireland, and the spouses, immediate family members, dependents, and/or other persons living in the same household, are not eligible to participate.

By submitting an application, entrants agree and consent to their personal details, full name, area of residence, photographs and biographical information (in whole or in part), being published on the NCI website and in NCI publications, and other marketing material.

Students must be in financial and academic good standing with National College of Ireland by Friday 11th July 2025 in order to be deemed eligible for the scholarship.

3. HOW TO APPLY:

Applicants must submit the completed application form and supporting documentation no later than 5pm on 15th August 2025 by emailing <u>admissions@ncirl.ie</u>.

4. JUDGING AND SELECTION OF WINNERS:

Applications will be judged by a panel of adjudicators, and applicants may be required to attend an interview with the panel so that the successful applicant can be chosen.

Judging will be based on the impact an MBA would have the applicant's career.

5. SCHOLARSHIP DETAILS

The scholarship covers all enrollment fees. It does not cover books, materials, computers, travel or subsistence costs. The scholarship is available for the MBA. It cannot be used for other courses nor exchanged for cash or other alternatives. All courses run subject to numbers. If a course is not eligible to run, NCI will make an offer for an alternative postgraduate taught master's programme in a cognate field where possible. If the applicant deems this alternative course unsuitable or no alternative can be offered, NCI will rescind the awarding of the scholarship.

6. WINNER NOTIFICATION

The recipient of the scholarship will be informed by e-mail, using the address details provided in their application form.

7. SCHOLARSHIP REDEMPTION

In order to redeem their scholarship the individual must comply with the programme entry requirements for their chosen course of study, timeline and the application process at National College of Ireland.
