Hear from our Computing lecturer, Frances Sheridan, who will talk about what to expect when studying Computing at NCI.




Business Sample Lecture | Room: 2.08



Senior Library Assistant, Tamara Malone, will show you some of the spaces available to you as a student and learn about available resources and workshops.




Library Academic Support Team, Shannon Mallon, from the library academic support centre will inform you on how the library can support your academic success.
